



Inventory/Backstock Associate

vbs apparel (also known as Volleyball Stuff) is seeking a motivated and detail-oriented Inventory/Backstock Associate to support inventory management and backstock organization during the 2026 Nationals event. This role is ideal for someone with strong organizational skills, a keen eye for detail, and the ability to thrive in a high-energy, fast-paced retail environment. Reporting to the Inventory/Backstock Supervisor, the Inventory/Backstock Associate will assist with receiving, organizing, and maintaining inventory levels to ensure the retail booth remains fully stocked and operations run smoothly throughout the event.

Responsibilities:

- Assist with receiving and organizing inventory shipments, ensuring backstock is properly labeled, stored, and easy to access.
- Help maintain accurate inventory records and assist with stock counts and audits.
- Support the replenishment of stock in the retail booth by keeping an eye on inventory levels and alerting the Supervisor if stock is running low.
- Assist with tracking and reporting inventory movements, sales trends, and any discrepancies.
- Ensure all products are stored securely and that inventory handling procedures are followed to prevent loss.
- Help manage the organization and cleanliness of the backstock area to ensure smooth and efficient operations.
- Collaborate with the Inventory/Backstock Supervisor and other team members to ensure timely restocking and efficient operations during busy periods.
- Provide general support to the team by facilitating smooth operations during shift changes and breaks.
- Help with booth set-up and tear-down at the beginning and end of the event.

Qualifications:

- Prior experience in inventory management, stock control, or warehouse roles is a plus.
- Strong organizational skills and attention to detail.
- Ability to work in a fast-paced environment and stay organized under pressure.
- Ability to communicate effectively with team members and other departments.
- Ability to lift up to 50 lbs and stand for extended periods.
- Flexibility with work schedule to accommodate event hours.
- A positive, team-oriented attitude and willingness to pitch in where needed.

- This position is temporary and will be active during the 2026 Nationals event which will be held at the BMO Centre, Calgary.
- Hours will vary depending on the event schedule.
- Physical requirements include standing for extended periods and light lifting.
